A massive storm has hit Durban City and has caused severe flooding in the city and outskirts. It is understood that the storm has also knocked down the powerlines and caused outages in the suburbs on the southwest coast. The weather forecast predicts that another round of heavy rains is set to hit the province later today. KwaZulu-Natal, Eastern Cape and Mpumalanga is expected to be lashed by the rains and there is a prediction of snow in south parts of the Drakensberg. The heavy rainfall could lead to localised flooding along the coast, adjacent interior and extreme southern parts of the province.
