India-Lesotho Joint Bilateral Commission for Cooperation (JBCC)

30 September-01 October, 2019

The fourth round of Joint Bilateral Commission for Cooperation (JBCC) between India and Lesotho was held in Maseru on 30 September and 01 October 2019. The Lesotho delegation was led by Mt. Thabang Lekhele, Deputy Principal secretary, Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Relations. The Indian delegation was led by Dr Neena Malhotra, Joint Secretary (East and Southern Africa Division) of the Ministry of External Affairs of India.

During the Consultations, the two sides reviewed the entire gamut of bilateral cooperation. Both sides also exchanged views on regional and international issues of mutual interest.

Both sides reviewed the progress of the decisions taken during the last meeting of the JBCC held in New Delhi in December 2017.
